Cynological CV ~ Oliver Neubrand

Grown into the world of dog sport and breeding from day one – my father Alfons is breeding and competing in Rottweilers since about 40 years.

At the age of 11, competed the first time with a Rottweiler female in a BH Trial and also in the same year in the first Klub Sieger Show!

Milestones as a Handler in Schutzhund Sport:

Competing at the age of 16 at the All Breed Youth Championships in SchH3 With 20 years of age, first participation at the ADRK (Allgemeinen Deutschen Rottweiler-

Klub e.V.) DM (Deutsche Meisterschaft)! I have been competing at the ADRK DM for 10 years in role with 6 different dogs. Winning it twice with two own bred dogs. In 2004 with *Unkas vom Hause Neubrand* as youngest handler of all times! In 2008 with *Ives vom Hause Neubrand* still youngest winning handler!

I have been competing with three different dogs at the FCI Qualifications called VDH DM (toughest Schutzhund competition in Germany) which is the All Breed Selection for the National Team! The dogs I did compete there have been *Fax*, *Unkas* and *Ben*!

At the 2005 IFR (International Federation of Rottweiler friends) World Championships I did compete with *Unkas vom Hause Neubrand* - placed 6th in the individual race and won the titles Protection World Champion 2005 as well as Team World Champion 2005!

As a handler I did pass with 8 different dogs in the ADRK Körung!

Over the last 20- years I had titled about 30 dogs from 0 to VPG3 numerous dogs to the BH, VPG1 and ZtP

Protection Helper:

• I started to learn to be a protection helper at the age of 14. At the age of 16 I achieved the license of an ADRK Helper. With the age of 18, I was the youngest helper ever in any organization working a National Championship the DM in the ADRK.

Over the last few years I worked only a few National Events since I was competing almost at every possible event with one of my dogs.

- But I did work two ADRK Körungs, 4 Landesgroup Championships and once the ADRK DM. I was helper at more than 100 local trials and did also work numerous ZTP's.
- Besides that I do have also the <u>license of the All Breed Dog Sport Organization</u> where I was helper at several qualification trials as well working as teaching helper!
- This year I worked the ADRK FCI Qualification and I am in the final qualification to be the helper for the FCI Qualifier (all breed championship called the VDH DM).
- Since about 10 years I am travelling around the world holding seminars about Schutzhund and doing helperwork all over the world. Also since about 10 years I do helper-work on a professional base in two different clubs in Switzerland.
- In my local ADRK Club, the BG Allgäu Bodensee, I am the Helper for almost 20 years and since about 10 years the Head Train Warden of the Club!



• In the Landesgroup Oberschwaben I am the Head Train Warden since 3 years and responsible for the organization of the qualification trial as well as in charge of the helper education. The Landesgroup Oberschwaben is the strongest LG in the ADRK for numerous years!

Trainer:

As mentioned earlier I am working as the Trainer in different positions. I want to mention a few things:

 My local group the BG Allgäu Bodensee – has been competing with different handlers in National and International Championships as well as Körungs consistently year by year since I am in the position of the Train Warden.

A few very successful dogs from our Club:

~ Valentino vom Hause Neubrand with handler Petra Kiebler 3 x participant at the ADRK DM, 1 x at the IFR WM, and also passed the Lifetime Körung!

~ *Enrico vom Hause Neubrand* with handler Susanne Kiebler 2 x participant at the ADRK Dm, 1 x at the IFR WM and also passed the Körung.

• In Switzerland I am trainer of two different clubs - one is the Regional Group of the Swiss Rottweiler Club and the other one is a Sport Dog Group.

~ In the last 10 years we had 6 participants at the IFR WM and especially last year we were winning with *Kirou vom Hause Neubrand* and handler Lise Tobler IFR Protection World Champion 2009!

~ Recently we have again two dogs qualified for the IFR in Denmark in 2010 which are *Kirou* and *Hoss vom Hause Neubrnad* with the handlers Lise Tobler and Ronny Gruber.

• In the Sport Dog Group I am training all breeds since about 3 years.

In this time we had the following success:

WUSV Participant 2009 (GSD Fox vom Gempenblick) WUSV Participant 2010 (GSD Eycko von der Burg Hirschberg) FCI WM Participant 2009 (GSD Fox vom Gempenblick) ATIBOX WM Participant 2009 and 2010 (Boxer World Championship) FMBB Participant 2009 (Malinois World Championship)

• We also had the 2009 Swiss GSD Champion and several Swiss National Championship participants and World Championship Qualification participants.
